



Founding Families Society:

The St. Petersburg Museum of History is conducting a Founding Families History Project. The purpose of this project is to interview families whose forbearers have lived in St. Petersburg from the late 1800s through 1940. An inaugural reception to introduce the project was held on Feb. 26, 2009. Over 200 members and others attended the event. Family photos were displayed and family representatives shared their stories. The event was a success!

Our present goal is to interview representatives from one hundred families regarding how their family first came to St. Petersburg and succeeding events. The histories taken will be recorded, transcribed, and maintained in the Museum Archives.

The project is expected to result in new information regarding the founding of the city and its development over the years. This information will be made available to local historians as well as the general public as an important resource for future research on the origins, challenges, and progress of St. Petersburg. Selections from the interviews will be published.
